The Gutenberg Bible

The Gutenberg Bible, also known as the 42-line Bible, is the first substantial book printed with movable metal type and was completed in 1454 or 1455. The printing process, developed by Johannes Gutenberg in Mainz, Germany, allowed multiple copies of a given text to be produced more rapidly and uniformly than was possible with

hand copying. This revolutionary technology accelerated the spread of new ideas and laid the way to the Renaissance, the Scientific Revolution, and the Reformation.

Little is known about Johannes Gutenberg (ca. 1397-1468), although some of his work on the Bible around 1452. A legal document dated 1455 shows that Gutenberg was sued by his partner, Johann Faust, for the return of large sums of money used in

"the mark of the books." This phrase undoubtedly refers to the production of the 42-line Bible.

Gutenberg's wooden press was modified on the vineyard used in local vineyards as well as the papermaker's press. The printing type was made of a flexible metal alloy, but exactly how the type was cast and what kind of mold

was used is still a matter of debate. The Gothic letterforms are similar to those used in Northern European manuscripts of the same period.

The Harry Ransom Center's Gutenberg Bible, acquired in 1978, is one of forty-eight surviving copies and one of only two complete copies in the United States.

Between 151 and 180 copies are thought to have been produced. The most valuable include the Old and New Testaments, and the Latin text is that of the Vulgate prepared by St. Jerome. The Bible contains many handwritten additions to the text indicating that it was used several times. We know little about its history before the late 1700s.


