## I. The U.S. – ROK Alliance



Finding: Americans positively assess the value of the U.S.–ROK alliance in East Asia.

#### II. U.S. Military Presence in South Korea



Finding: American support for a long-term U.S. military presence in South Korea is relatively strong.

#### **III. North Korea Nuclear Issue**



Finding: Americans support U.S. negotiations with North Korea as a means to end its nuclear program.

## **IV. North-South Conflict**



Finding: American support for U.S. military intervention to aid South Korea in the event of a North Korean attack is stronger in the context of a UN-sponsored multilateral effort.

#### V. Korea-U.S. Free Trade Agreement



Finding: American support for Senate approval of the Korea-U.S. free trade agreement is lukewarm; this appears to be the case with free trade agreements in general and is not particular to Korea.
